

HARPERSFIELD TOWNSHIP

PUBLIC HEARING

Held on May 1, 2017

The Board of Harpersfield Township held a public hearing from 6:30 to 7 PM in the Harpersfield Township Administration Building.

The purpose for the public hearing was to discuss and decide to proceed with an addendum to the JEDD III agreement that the Township has with City of Geneva.

Jim Pristov, Vice Chairman, opened the public hearing with the following members and visitors present:

As Attorney Malchesky could not be in attendance at the meeting, the Board proceeded with a phone conference call. The Board questioned if he had time to review the proposed addendum. He responded that he had and the only recommendation that he had was regarding collecting residential income tax. He said the addendum should be worded: "follow the law to collect income tax to residents in JEDD III" and in his opinion it is just for housing project/subdivision that allows the collection of income tax.

He instructed the Board of the next step in the process:

Make the original contract with added addendum available on the Township website

Post the proposed addendum on the website and in the local newspaper.

Set a public hearing after 30 days to allow the public to review this information.

Cliff made a motion to post the addendum for 30 days and the public hearing will be held on June 19, 2017, at 6:30 PM (prior to our regular meeting); Jim seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.
