PUBLIC HEARING

Held on November 20, 2017

The Board of Harpersfield Township held a public hearing for the purpose to hear public opinion on a decision to place Old 534 on non-maintained status.

Ray described the three options that the Board had:

Keep the road status as it currently is; vacate; or place on non-maintained status

After discussing these options, the Board requested the opinion of the Tim Martin, County Engineer, and his response was: "It is my advisory opinion that placing Old 534 on non-maintained status will not unduly adversely affect the flow of the motor vehicle traffic on Old 534 or on any adjacent road".

The Board asked if there was any public comment at this time.

Cassie Parker asked the Board to question the County Prosecutor of the legality of installing a gate (which she would keep unlocked).
