

# HARPERSFIELD TOWNSHIP

## REGULAR SESSION

Held on May 23, 2022

The Board of Harpersfield Township convened in regular session from 7 PM to 8:05 PM in the Harpersfield Township Administration Building. Ed Spoor, Chairman, called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

The minutes from the regular session held on May 9, 2022 were reviewed. Jim made a motion to approve the minutes as written; Ray seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.

Cody informed the Board that he has the contract for Western Reserve to construct the pavilion in Harpersfield Cemetery. The cost for material and labor will be \$24,900 (due prior to construction \$1,000 signing fee and \$15,000 down payment); the Board agreed to the color black for the steel roof material.

Cody stated that R. W Sidley will hold the price for the new Mack (that was quoted in 2021) and it is scheduled to start being built in July 2022. Henderson Products contacted Cody and there will be an upcharge of \$1053.84 on their 2021 quote (they listed the differences in the material to build the dump body); Jim made a motion to allow for the increase in cost; Ray seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.

Ray made a motion to pay the following bills: #13004 through #13019; totaling \$11,001.36; Jim seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.

Sharon reported the following receipts: #89-2022 through #91-2022; totaling \$15,526.21.

Sharon reported that the 2020 and 2021 AUP audit is complete and there were no findings.

Jim and Larry spoke with Sarah Fowler, State Rep, about putting "Harpersfield" on the I-90 exit ramp sign. Larry has a picture that on I-90 exit ramp for Rt. 20 it has Kingsville under Ashtabula. Sarah stated she would look into it.

Ray reported that Ashtabula County Engineer will conduct a traffic count study on County Line Road; a resident has requested that the speed limit be lowered to 45 MPH.

Ray was contacted by the Ashtabula County Commissioners to determine if the Township will agree to a "quick claim" deed for the land given to the Township from the Commissioners to enlarge the driveway area to the north side of the admin/fire station building. The Trustees unanimously agreed to allow for the quick claim deed.

Ray commented that Norm and Yvonne Sweeney, 1885 South Broadway, have submitted an application to join JEDD III; there is no objection to allow them to join the district and to eventually allow them to connect to the sewer.

Sean Starner attended the meeting to voice a situation he is having with Larry regarding his desire to build a "barn" structure prior to building a "house" structure. The conversation and accusations became quite heated; nothing was being resolved; and as Chairman, Ed shut it down.

Meeting adjourned until June 20, 2022
