

HARPERSFIELD TOWNSHIP

REGULAR SESSION

Held on September 23, 2024

The Board of Harpersfield Township convened in regular session from 7 PM to 8:30 PM in the Administration Building. James Pristov, Chairman, called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

The minutes from the regular session held on September 9, 2024 were reviewed. Ed made a motion to approve the minutes as written; Mickey seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.

Jim Belding gave a very extensive presentative on installing a collabarium wall in the cemetery. I have listed a few of the ideas he made us aware of: each niche will hold two urns but will have one door; advised us to make a decision on the uniform style of lettering; explained the cost and recommended pricing for each niche; after our decision is made to proceed it will be 4-5 months for delivery.

Ed made a motion to accept the quote Rocky Road Paving submitted to pave the parking area (from the south corner to the road) for the Administration/Fire station building at a cost of \$51,300; Mickey seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.

Larry informed the Board that he asked Marilyn Niciu to wash the windows in the Administration Building. The Board allowed this expense but instructed Larry to ask the Board prior to contacting Marilyn in the future.

Larry asked the Board to support the zoning rule of no signs of any kind – including political signs – within 200 feet of the roundabout. The Board agreed to this request.

Mickey made a motion to pay the following bills: #14287 through #14306 totaling \$38,697.39; Ed seconded; the Board voted unanimously in favor.

Sharon reported the following receipts: #243-2024 through #257-2024; totaling \$49805.37.

Mickey commented that the Friends of the Park Christmas event will be held at the Harpersfield Park from noon to 2 PM.

Ed questioned ODOT on who is responsible for the maintenance mowing for the roundabout and was told that it is ODOT but they do not have a mower in Ashtabula County that is able to mow the mound. (they have to wait till another area is finished using one to be able to borrow it).

The Board agreed to allow a road open cut to install a water line on Bishop Road near Truckmen.

Jim commented that the Ashtabula County Commissioners meeting that was held in our Administration Building went well and had residents in attendance.
